

Editorial Policy

The mission of *The Journal of Japanese Operations Management and Strategy (JOMS)* is to serve as the primal research journal in operations management in Japan. The journal publishes academic research into the problems and concerns of managers who design and manage the product and process in manufacturing and service industries. It covers all the operations related issues such as the effective and efficient management in product development, procurement, production, distribution and marketing, manufacturing/operations strategy, decision makings in global operation, supply chain management, and service sciences among others. The journal welcomes the submission of rigorous and scientific research papers using any research paradigm such as social science, case study, and mathematical modeling.

The submitted papers are first judged by the editorial committee whether they have a reasonable prospect to fit with the mission of JOMS, and they proceed to the refereeing process. In the refereeing process, at least two referees are assigned to review a paper, and the editorial committee makes the final decision in terms of acceptance/revision required/rejection. The important criteria of acceptance are whether the paper has managerial relevance or the research outcomes are useful in management, whether it has academic merits in originality and transferability, and/or whether it has rigor and clarity. In addition, the manuscript has to be readable and well organized and exhibit good writing style.

Submission

JOMS welcomes papers written in either Japanese or English. The authors must follow the instruction for contributors and use the template, JOMS Format, which are posted at the JOMSA home page (<http://e-jomsa.jp/annaieng.html>) in preparing their manuscripts. Manuscripts should be submitted electronically in a PDF file (without security protection) to the Editor-in-Chief, Hirofumi Matsuo (matsuo@kobe-u.ac.jp). The authors of the submitted paper can be either the member of JOMSA or non-member. The submission fee of 10,000 yen for an article must be remitted to JOMSA in advance of submission for non-member. Note that this submission fee is waived if one of the authors is a member of JOMSA. The remittance fee should be paid by the authors, too. These fees will not be returned.

Submission of a manuscript to the journal implies that the paper has not been copyrighted or published elsewhere, nor is it being refereed elsewhere at the same time. This applies both to the paper as a whole as well as to major contributions and subsections in the paper. Once a manuscript has been accepted for publication, its authors are asked to sign a copyright transfer agreement. The copyright of the paper published in JOMS belongs to Japanese Operations Management and Strategy Association (JOMSA). If any copyright problem arises in relation to a published paper, its authors are responsible for its consequence. No part of the publication may be reproduced, stored, transmitted, or disseminated, in any form, or by any means, without prior written permission from JOMSA.
